Post RN Certificate of Perioperative Nurse Program

Fall 2008 quarter

Introduction to Perioperative Nursing, 6 credit hours, this online course includes the AORN Periop 101 Course, the gold standard of perioperative education, and is an introduction to the foundations for practice as a perioperative nurse.

Surgical Procedures for the Perioperative Nurse, 4 credit hours, this online course is designed to teach the student about surgical procedures and the skills necessary to perform in the role of perioperative nursing.

OR Laboratory for the Perioperative Nurse, 2 credit hours, this course is designed to allow the student to experience the role of perioperative nursing within a classroom laboratory setting. The course consists of 40 contact hours of lab.

Winter 2009 quarter

Perioperative Nurse Externship I, 10 credit hours, this is an experiential course, in which the student is assigned a clinical setting for hands-on learning, under the guidance of a preceptor. The student will complete 30 hours per week, for a total of 300 externship hours.

Advanced Surgical Procedures for the Perioperative Nurse, 2 credit hours, this online course is an extension of Surgical Procedures for the Perioperative Nurse, this course provides further instruction in the role of the perioperative nurse in complex, specialty surgeries.

Spring 2009 quarter

Perioperative Nurse Externship II, 10 credit hours, this course is an experiential course for the student who wishes to gain further insight into the role of perioperative nursing. In this experience, the student will be placed in a clinical setting different from the first externship, to allow the student further opportunity to experience the broad scope of practice in perioperative nursing. Student has 30 clinical hours per week with preceptor the student is assigned a clinical setting for hands-on learning, under the guidance of a preceptor. The student will complete 30 hours per week, for a total of 300 externship hours.

Management of Perioperative Care, 3 credit hours, this online course is a leadership course, designed to give the student instruction regarding management and supervision functions with the realm of perioperative nursing.
