COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS HUB

A universal screening tool is used by healthcare providers and community agencies to identify if a patient has unmet needs and if they are interested in receiving help to address those needs. The patient is then referred into the HUB where they work with a community health worker, nurse and/or social worker to address their unmet needs.
