






MHC Hospitalization Trends

As of January 5 at 8:00am, 5,371 Healthcare Team members have received their first vaccine.


- # Pfizer 4,672 doses administered

 Food & Agriculture, Utilities, Police,
 Firefighters, Corrections Officers,
 Transportation) Adults 75 years and
 older
- Tier 1c: High Risk Adults
- Tier 2: General Population






How Do I Get Vaccinated?
