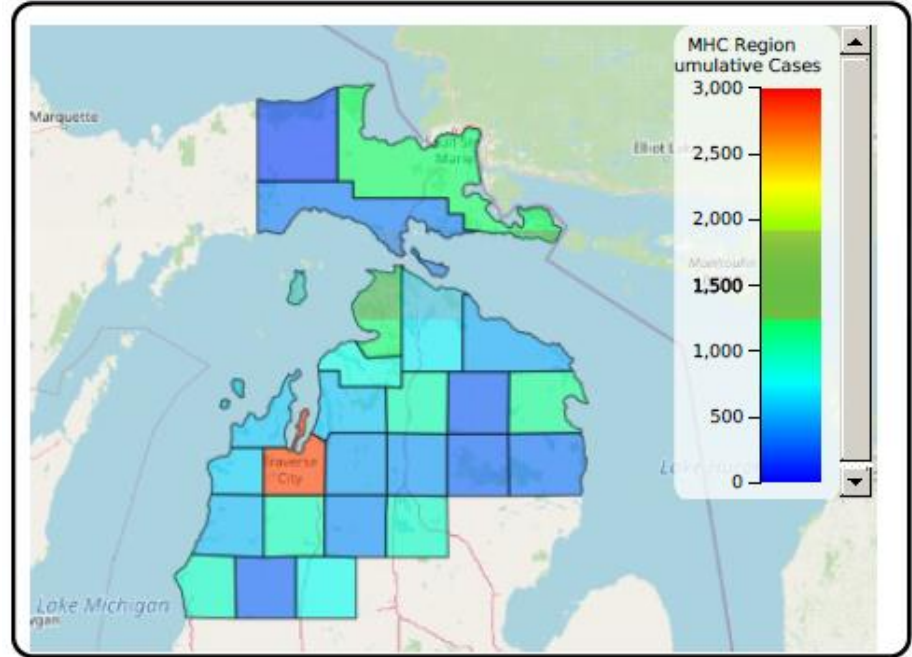

Munson Healthcare Status

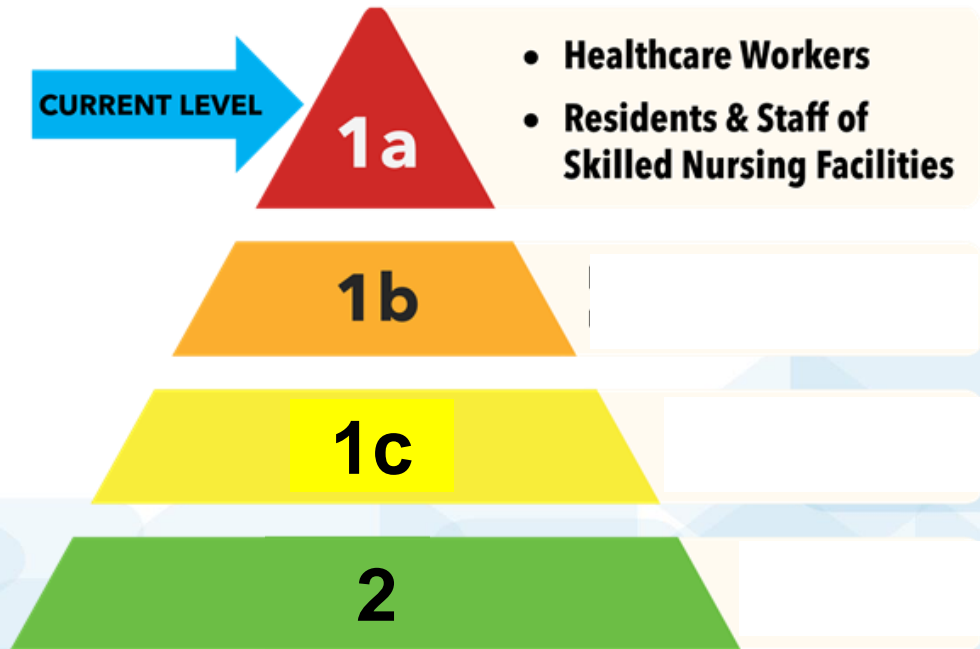
- **Expecting to receive a second shipment of 2,925 doses of Pfizer vaccine December 22.**
- **Expecting to receive first shipment of 2,400 doses of Moderna vaccine December 23.**



MHC Vaccine Prioritization

- Tier 1a: Healthcare Personnel and Long Term Care Residents
- Tier 1b: Essential Workers: People who play a key role in keeping essential functions of society running and cannot socially distance in the workplace (e.g., Education Sector, Food & Agriculture, Utilities, Police, Firefighters, Corrections Officers, Transportation)
 - **New: Adults 75 years and older in Tier 1B**
- Tier 1c: High Risk Adults
- Tier 2: General Population

COVID-19 Vaccine Priority Levels



mRNA COVID-19 Vaccine Updated Recommendations

- **Should not be given within 90 days of someone having ~~COVID-19~~, or received COVID-19 Convalescent plasma or a monoclonal antibody.**
- **People who have tested positive for COVID-19 can receive the vaccine at any time as long as you are not acutely ill.**
- **Wait two weeks between receiving other vaccinations.**

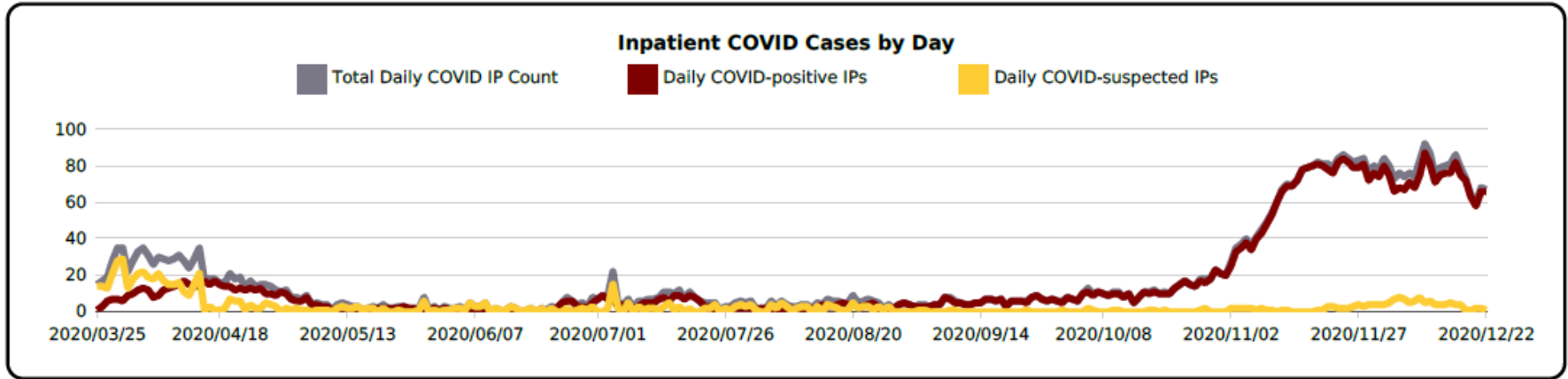

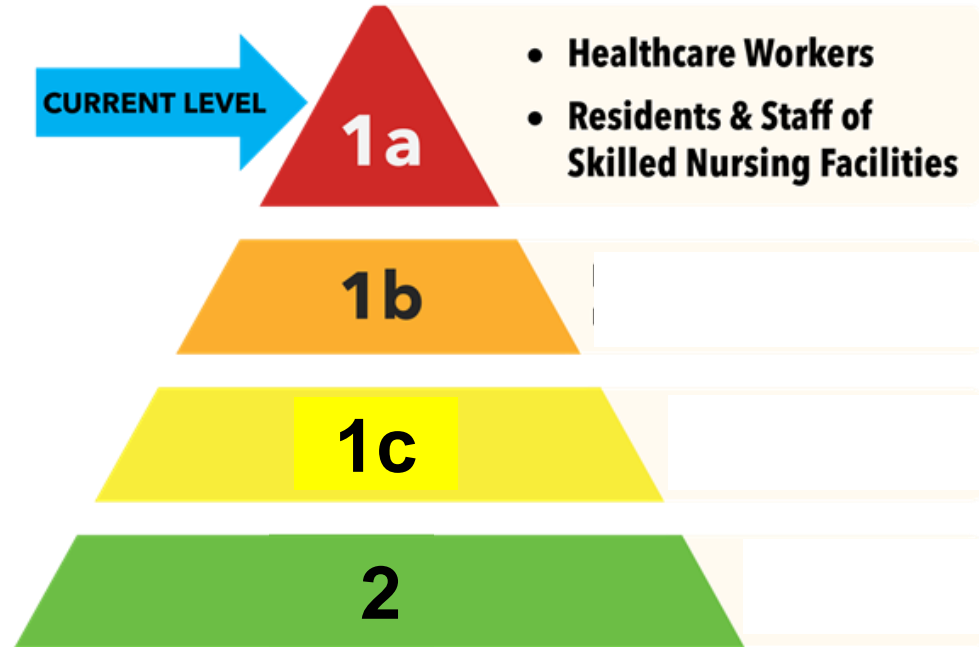
MHC Hospitalization Trends
