






Healthcare Worker Vaccinations by Munson Healthcare

- 61 % of eligible employees and credentialed providers vaccinated


























Data About Population Age 65+

State of Michigan (65+)



Vaccine Allocation

- Each FQHC, Health Department, Hospital,
 Primary Care Office, Pharmacy (CVS and Walgreens), etc. are receiving vaccine allocation separately at different times.
- Counts and requests are based on the number of employees, patients, and residents.
- Allocations continue to remain uncertain.
- Over 270,000 doses requested to the State, and only 60,000 filled.
- Our collective goal is fair and equitable distribution, however, there is no centralized process, so it will look different in each county.



Northwest Michigan Health Services

Serving western counties from Traverse City to Shelby

- At this time Northwest Michigan Health Services is unable to order vaccines.
- Our hope is to order in two weeks.
- At this time we are partnering up with the LHDs to help support their vaccination efforts including vaccinating patients of NMHSI.
- Please contact your local Health Department to sign up.
- The Mobile Health Clinic has arrived and being prepared to be used to deliver the vaccine into our rural communities.
 - Focusing on those most vulnerable (egg. People with chronic illnesses, homeless, migrant/agricultural workers, group living, minorities and others with barriers to accessing healthcare)

Focus of Distribution Plan

- Completing Phase 1A, preparing for Phase 1B
- Goals of vaccinating nearly 700 this week based on current vaccine availability
- Vaccination clinics are expanding to larger scale on January 18th expanding to that same amount of people daily starting week of 18th (*3500 based on vaccine availability)

- Strategizing with hospitals, FQHC's and schools to begin >65 and school staff
- Working closely with County Emergency Managers closed pod planning

- Due to vaccine limitations, we are prioritizing Phase 1A and some of Phase 1B including persons 65+, first responders, jails/corrections staff only
