





# Daily Trends in Number of COVID-19 Cases in the United States Reported to CDC


Daily Trends in Number of COVID-19 Cases in the United States Reported to CDC

# **COVID-19 Treatment Options Remain Limited**

#### **Vaccination is Your Best Option**

#### **COVID-19 Infusion Treatment**

for Patients with Mild to Moderate Symptoms

If qualified, monoclonal antibody therapy for patients 12+ years must be administered within 10 days of the onset of symptoms.










### **COVID-19 Vaccine Dashboard: Region 7**

# COVID-19 "Booster" Vaccines for Moderately to Severely Immunocompromised People

- CDC recommends that people with moderately to severely compromised immune systems receive an additional dose of mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least 28 days after a second dose of <u>Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine</u> or <u>Moderna COVID-19 vaccine</u>.
- CDC does **not** recommend additional doses or booster shots for any other population at this time.
- We will continue to monitor new recommendations as they become available.



## Why Get Tested If You Are Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms?

- Protect others around you by preventing the spread of the virus.
- Monoclonal Antibody Therapy must be completed within the first
   10 days of the onset of symptoms.
- COVID-19 has a 2.2% mortality rate and it 20 times more lethal than Influenza.


## **Masking Recommendations for School Age Children**



- The American Academy of Pediatrics, CDC and MDHHS all strongly recommend masking to ensure the safe return to school.

- The Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) is an immunization database that documents immunizations given to Michiganders throughout life.
- Michigan residents can now log on to MCIR and request vaccine records.

# Health Department of Northwest Michigan and Benzie Leelanau District Health Department

Lisa Peacock, Health Officer

- Although not increasing as much as past few weeks, still seeing uptick in number of COVID-19 cases across health department jurisdictions. With exception of a few areas, all counties in HDNW and BLDHD are at substantial or high transmission level designation.
- Working with local businesses and school district leaders on mitigation and safe practices for their employees, students and visitors.
- Agree with CDC/state/local recommendation for universal masking policies for K-12 students, staff, visitors.
- Working with MDHHS to increase capacity for testing; offering weekend testing.
- Partnering with K-12 and community colleges for clinics for students/families.
- CDC recommends testing 3-5 days after exposure regardless of vaccination status

- Case trends:
  - Cases increasing: August 2 August 8= **152** cases; August 9-August 15= **181** cases
  - Daily cases per million increasing: July 30 = 64.5; August 6 = 71.81
  - Percent positivity **increasing**: July 30 = **3.65%**; August 6 = **7.18%**
  - Delta variant identified in 7 of 10 counties (Crawford, Mason, Mecosta, Missaukee, Newaygo, Oceana, Wexford)
- Total vaccines administered by DHD#10: 104,636 as of 8/11/21
- Numerous pop-up clinics scheduled go to <u>www.dhd10.org/events</u>
- Walk-ins welcome during the week, encourage calling ahead or coming during normal clinic dates and times – vary for each county, check website for more info
