



PEAK NUMBERS FROM EACH OF THE THREE COVID-19 PATIENT SURGES





Daily new confirmed and probable cases per million by age group (7-day rolling average)




- · Case rate trends for most age groups saw increases following the Thanksgiving holiday but are decreasing again

Let's Band Together.

- Get vaccinated and get boosted.
- Wear a mask in public indoor settings and when serving food.
- Ventilate gathering spaces as much as possible or get outside.



- Continue to practice social distancing.
- Wash hands frequently, especially before preparing, eating, or serving food.
- Communicate in advance with guests about your COVID-19 ground rules and the precautions you're taking.
- Delay travel if you are not vaccinated or feeling sick.
