# Required ICD-10 Data Elements for Orders/EMR Templates Orthopedics

### Acuity

• Acute, Chronic, Acute on Chronic

# Laterality

· Right, left, bilateral

#### Dislocation

- Current, Recurrent
- Traumatic, congenital, pathologic
- A-C joint: w displacement 100%, >200%

## Osteoporosis

- With or without current fracture
- Age-related or other specific cause
- Hx of any (healed) osteoporotic fx
- · Major osseous defect if any

## Pathologic Fractures

• Due to: wedging, collapse, osteoporosis, neoplastic disease, age-related (senile, postmenopausal), other

#### Traumatic Fractures

- Specify displaced vs. non-displaced
- Type: greenstick, torus, spiral
  - Gustilo Open Fracture (radius, femur)
  - Salter -Harris Physeal Fractures
  - Neer, proximal humerus
- Healing status:
  - New open or closed fracture
  - Routine healing
  - Delayed healing



- Nonunion, malunion
- Sequela specify the previous injury

# • Timing/Episode of Care

- Initial (active phase of treatment)
- Subsequent (after care)
- Sequela ( late effect)

# Anatomic specificity is a must!

- Finger Individual fingers and phalanxes
  - Non-displaced fracture of proximal phalanx of left index finger, initial encounter for closed fracture S62.641A
- Toe individual toes and specific joints
  - Dislocation of inter-phalangeal joint of right great toe, initial encounter \$93.111A
- Hand individual metacarpals
  - Displaced fracture of base of second metacarpal bone, right hand, initial encounter for closed fracture S62.310A
- Foot individual metatarsals
  - Non-displaced fracture of third metatarsal bone, right foot, initial encounter for closed fracture \$92.334A

## Head Injury

Length of time of any loss of consciousness: 30 min or less, 31-59 min, 1 hr – 5:59 hrs and 6 to 24 hrs

# · Circumstances of injury

- Accidental
- Intentional self-harm
- An assault
- Of undetermined cause
- External cause (activity, location)
