Effective immediately, Point of care testing for the blood gas parameters pO2 and pCO2 on the I-stat instrument is discontinued hospital wide. TCO₂, Base excess, HCO₃, and O₂ saturation will also be unavailable.

This is due to the I-stat instrument's failure to pass recent proficiency testing challenges from our lab accrediting body, the College of American Pathologists.

This means that all testing for pO2 and pCO2 must be performed in the main lab, not at the patient bedside.

This will be in effect for a minimum of 6 months.

If this affects your practice in any way we need to speak with you ASAP to consider work arounds.
