Effective immediately, Point of care testing for the blood gas parameters pO2 and pCO2 on the l-stat instrument is discontinued hospital wide. $\mathrm{TCO}_{2}$, Base excess, $\mathrm{HCO}_{3}$, and $\mathrm{O}_{2}$ saturation will also be unavailable.

This is due to the l-stat instrument's failure to pass recent proficiency testing challenges from our lab accrediting body, the College of American Pathologists.

This means that all testing for pO 2 and pCO 2 must be performed in the main lab, not at the patient bedside.

This will be in effect for a minimum of 6 months.
If this affects your practice in any way we need to speak with you ASAP to consider work arounds.
